- Comprehension of fish and wildlife science and conservation practices
- Familiarity with ecological and/or fisheries management principles
- Special event experience

- Word processing and data entry skills
- Good organizational skills and ability to keep accurate records

Duties:

- Conduct habitat recovery projects for Sierra Nevada yellow-legged frog in North Central Region. Projects include the use of gill nets to remove fish from high elevation lakes in the central Sierra Nevada.
- Collect data on net contents (fish species) and habitat conditions and record on data sheets during the surveys.
- Work extended hours in the field (4-5 days), strenuous physical activities (hiking using GPS navigation, pulling nets, carrying equipment), and overnight camping.
- Data entry using excel on a department computer and quality assurance procedures for data collected during habitat recovery projects.
- Perform routine maintenance of field equipment for project. Maintenance may include net repair, washing, decontamination, gear preparation, and organization of equipment in the project locker.
